CHRISTIAN AID

Christian Aid annual collection week is from 12 to 18 May this year. Christian Aid has had a very challenging year with situations in Ukraine, Gaza, many parts of Africa and elsewhere and depends heavily on the Annual collection to be able to provide the vital support in development activities and disaster situations. On the local front the Ballynahinch CA group collection last year was considerably down compared with past years, due partly to less house to house collectors and partly to competition within First with the SAT7 Appeal. The house to house Collection depends almost completely now on First and some of the stalwarts of past years are no longer able to do this on health grounds so we urgently need a new group of volunteers!! If you are able to walk




First Walking Group


Our culture says that the most important things for children are education, good health, treats, entertainment, and material things.





A Living Sacrifice

12 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. ² Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

³ For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. ⁴ For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, ⁵ so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. ⁶ We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us.

If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your a faith; ⁷ if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; ⁸ if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, ¹⁰ do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.
